

Remedial Teaching

The institution has an established mechanism to harness the potential of slow learners. The state funded Student Support Programme and the Remedial Coaching programmes coordinated by the departments cater to the needs of the weaker students in their learning pursuits.

The programme aims to improve academic skills and linguistic proficiency of the students in various subjects, to raise their level of comprehension of basic subjects to provide a stronger foundation for further academic work, to strengthen their knowledge, skills and attitudes in such subjects, where quantitative and qualitative techniques and laboratory activities are involved so that proper guidance and training provided under the programme may enable the students to come up to the level necessary for pursuing higher studies efficiently. During the year 2013-13, 44 students were selected and given remedial coaching. During the year 2014-15, 82 students were selected and given support for improving their academic performance. During the year 2015-16, 221 students were enrolled to given special coaching for their academics. During the year, 2016-17, 150 students were selected and trained specially to improve their overall performance.
