NAAC SPONSORED NATIONAL SEMINAR ON INTEGRATION OF TECHNOLOGY IN TEACHING LEARNING AND EVALUATION PROCESS

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Nirmala College, Muvattupuzha successfully organised the NAAC sponsored two-day national seminar on Integration of Technology in Teaching, Learning and Evaluation Process. Dr. James Mathew, Principal of the college explained the background of the seminar in his welcome address. The seminar was inaugurated by **Sri. V K Siljo, Director of International Collaborations, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India.** His inaugural address shed light on the international opportunities available for young research scholars and PG students. Msgr. Rev. Dr. Cherian Kanjirakombil presided over the function.





There were four technical sessions that dealt with varying aspects of central theme of the seminar. In the first technical session **Dr.Devender S Kawday, Deputy Adviser** of NAAC elaborated on the revised A & A framework of NAAC. In Technical session II, Dr.Sreekanth D gave practical exposure to the participants on the topic “Moodle as a MOOC platform. In technical session III, Dr. M Rajesh, Regional Director, Indira Gandhi National Open University gave hands on training on “Developing Online Content for LMS”. In Technical session IV, as many as 26 participants presented their papers in two parallel tracks. There were 105 participants in total. Dr. Sony Kuriakose, IQAC coordinator presented a review of the seminar in the valedictory session.
