The Management of the above trust will execute an agreement with Government as per the conditions given below.

1. The Educational Agency will agree to submit the documents to prove that the College has adequate infrastructure, human and physical to conduct the course as required by the Government.
2. The Educational Agency will agree to abide by the procedure of admission in the college as decided by the Government from time to time.
3. The Educational Agency will agree to set apart 50% of the seats of the course for being filled up by the Government or such authority determined by Government on the basis of merit and reservation principles followed by the Government and the remaining 50% filled by the Educational Agency on the basis of merit.
4. The Educational Agency will agree to collect only such fees as determined by the Government from time to time from the students admitted to the college for the course
5. The Educational Agency will agree to institute adequate number of scholarships on merit cum means basis as determined by the Government from time to time to the students admitted to the course.
6. The Educational Agency will agree to appoint and fix the service conditions of the teachers and non teaching staff in the college for conducting the course as followed by Government in conducting similar courses.
7. The Educational Agency will agree to institute an appropriate governance structure that would ensure transparency, efficiency and social accountability in the Educational agency as determined by the Government from time to time.



8. The Educational Agency will agree to publish the details regarding the establishment and governance of Educational agency, admission, fees, courses, results, teaching and other staff, and any further information as required by the Government on the website of the Educational agency
9. The Educational Agency will agree to run only courses approved by the Government and the concerned University.
10. The Educational Agency will agree to enable the Government and its representatives to check, verify and monitor the compliance of the conditions mentioned above at any time the Government so decides.
11. The Educational Agency will agree to enter into an agreement with the affiliating University on the terms determined by the affiliating University in respect of all or any of the matters contained in this agreement.
12. In the event of admitted breach of any of the conditions mentioned above by the Educational agency, the Government is authorized to adjudicate the quantum of compensation which the Educational Agency is liable to pay to the Government, if any, and upon such adjudication, the educational agency shall pay to Government the amount so fixed, failing which the amount of compensation adjudicated should be recoverable under the provision of Kerala Revenue Recovery Act, 1968, as if they were public revenue due on land.

The University Grants Commission has sanctioned financial assistance under NSQF to start new B Voc Courses in various aided arts & science colleges for the academic year 2018-19. Accordingly, the applications submitted by the Principals & Managers of aided colleges vide paper (1) read above, for starting new B Voc Courses were considered by the University even though they were submitted after the statutory date.

The duly constituted Inspection Commissions vide paper (2), (3) & (4) read above, assessed the facilities available with the colleges. The recommendations of the Inspection Commission were considered by the Syndicate vide paper (5) read above, and resolved to sanction affiliation to B Voc Programmes subject to following conditions and orders were issued vide paper (6) read above.

1.The colleges should utilize the UGC fund to materialize the conduct of B Voc programmes in addition to the existing aided infrastructural facility available with the college.

2.The colleges shall not utilize the existing govt / aided infrastructural facility to run the B Voc programmes.

3.The colleges shall prepare the syllabus & model question papers of the B Voc programmes immediately and submit it before the Academic Council for approval.

4.The affiliation granted to the programme will be subject to the assent of the Chancellor of the University to consider the late application submitted by the Colleges.

5.The U O sanctioning affiliation to the programme will be subject to the NOC from the government.

6.The Principal and the Manager of the college shall execute an agreement with the University by incorporating the conditions mentioned above.

Meanwhile, the University sought the sanction of the Hon'ble Chancellor to extend the time for considering the belated applications by the Syndicate up to 10.12.2018 and the Chancellor's office issued a notification vide paper (7) read above, to extend the period for considering the belated applications for affiliation of the new B Voc programmes in twelve colleges during the academic year 2018-19, up to 10.12.2018.

The Principals and the Managers of the twelve colleges executed an agreement with the University by incorporating the conditions mentioned above.



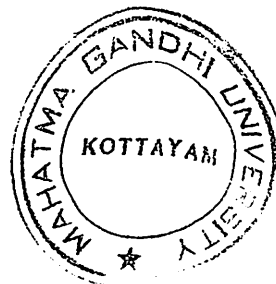



He is also the chairman of the Expert Committee for Revision of Curriculum for School Education, appointed by the Kerala government.

He received a D.Sc. in Ecology (2002) and a Ph.D. (1978) from the Department of Aquatic Biology & Fisheries, University of Kerala. He led the Department of Ecology and Marine Biology at the Saline Water Conversion Corporation Research and Development Centre, Saudi Arabia as chairman during 1993–2002. He was a Professor at Kerala University and Kerala Agricultural University before becoming Vice-Chancellor of the Cochin University of Science and Technology.

He was the Vice-Chancellor of Aligarh Muslim University from 11 June 2007 to 17 January 2012. During his term the university signed MoUs with Wisconsin University, Cleveland University, Atlanta University, Johns Hopkins University and New York University and began clearing a backlog of PhD submissions. India Today cited his efforts as leading to a "remarkable turnaround" for the university.
