Special programmes** were also conducted to make the **classes interesting, effective and more interactive.** These kind of preparations really improved the quality of curriculum delivery and teaching-learning process during this academic year.

II. HIGHLIGHTS OF THE YEAR

1. Nirmala College Reaccredited with A++ Grade (CGPA 3.73)

Though the Self Study Report (SSR) submission and Data Validation and Verification (DVV) process had been completed during the academic year 2019-20, the Peer Team Visit got delayed due to Covid 19. After a long wait, a three-member team consisting of **Prof. Mustafa Shah, former Vice Chancellor, University of Kashmir, Dr. Surekha Dangwal, Vice Chancellor, Doon University, Uttarkhand, and Dr. H Nanje Gowda, Former Principal, Mysore University** visited and evaluated qualitative processes in the college on 25th -26th February, 2021 and expressed great satisfaction over it. However, the Executive Committee of the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) decided to do a revisit without assigning any reasons. The college Governing Body, Staff Council and IQAC wholeheartedly welcome the decision of the NAAC and subsequently another Peer Team consisting of **Prof. J P Sharma, former Vice Chancellor, Mohanlal Sukhadia University**

Udaipur, Prof. Kalpana K Mahajan, Professor, Punjab University, Prof. Yasmeen Ashai, Principal, Government College for Women, Srinagar, Jammu & Kashmir, Dr. H Nagabhushana, Professor, Tumkur University, Karnataka and Dr. B S Ponmudiraj, Adviser, NAAC visited and made a strategic evaluation of the academic and other allied activities of the college on 30th -31st March 2021. On 8th April, NAAC announced the results and the college got reaccredited with A++ grade with a CGPA of 3.73, which is the highest among the affiliated colleges in India under the Revised Accreditation Framework (RAF).

2. Top University Positions

In the UG results announced in August 2020, the college bagged **24 top university positions**. Apart from this, the college also got **72 A+ grades and 154 A grades**. In the PG results, **18 students secured top university positions**. The details of top university positions are given below.

3. Changes at Helm

Rev. Fr. Paul Nedumpurath took charge as the Higher Education Secretary, Diocese of Kothamangalam during this academic year. Dr. James Mathew retired from service on 31.03.2020 after successful completion of his tenure and Dr. Thomas K V, Department of Mathematics took charge as principal on July 1, 2020. Prof. Saji Joseph acted as principal during the intervening period.

4. One Week Online Two-tier Induction Programme for UG and PG Students

The college has organized one week induction programme for the first year UG students during 22-30 October 2020. The induction programme for PG students was conducted during 29.12.2020 -04.01.2021. Both the programmes included activities and interactions as suggested in the UGC guidelines for conducting induction programmes. Induction programmes consisted of both **institutional orientation and department level curriculum induction sessions**. In the programme, the patron of the college Bishop Mar George Madathikandathil, Manager Msgr. Rev. Dr. Cherian Kanjirakombil, Higher Education Secretary Rev. Fr. Paul Nedumpurathu, Principal Dr. K V Thomas, Vice Principal Prof. Saji Joseph and Bursar Rev. Fr. Francis Kannadan addressed the students and parents. The programme also featured the talks of Mr. Harish Kumar and Dr. Civy V Pulayathu on the topics '**Design Your Destiny**' and '**New Generation Parenting**' respectively. Interactions with prominent alumni members have been included in department level induction programmes. The programme was initiated and coordinated by the IQAC of the college.

5. National Webinar on National Education Policy 2020

The IQAC of the college has organized a national webinar on the topic '**National Education Policy 2020: Reforming and Rejuvenating Teaching Learning in Higher Education Institutions for the 21st Century**' on 08.08.2020.



Dr. Shakila Shamsu, former OSD (NEP), Secretary to the Committee of Draft NEP,

Department of Higher Education, MHRD, New Delhi was the resource person. Dr. Sabu Thomas, Vice Chancellor of Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam inaugurated the programme. The event could attract more than 2,000 participants from the length and breadth of the country.

6. New Programme Sanctioned by the Government

During this academic year, the Government of Kerala sanctioned a new programme MSc Computer Science (Data Science). It is a five year integrated postgraduate programme.

7. Digitalization of Learning Process

The college continued its digitalization process during the academic year. Apart from the Google Meet platform, faculty members extensively use Zoom and Microsoft Teams for the purpose of curriculum delivery. Now all the first year students have to enroll in at least one online course hosted by Coursera or Edx. Department level coordinators help the students to select the courses. During this academic year the college got a **rating of 4.7 out of 5 from Coursera**. Further 68 students completed an online outreach programme on '**RS Applications in Agricultural Water Management**' offered by the **Indian Institute of Remote Science (IIRS)**. Dr. T M Jacob, Associate Professor, Postgraduate and Research Department of Statistics created an **online depository of free ICT tools** that can be used for teaching and learning. The faculty and students completed 3824 online courses during the academic year 2020-21. Out of the 3824 courses, 3,309 courses were done by students.



8. New Collaborations to Enhance the Global Competency among Students

The college has signed an MoU with **IMMO Infotech**, a **Switzerland** based software company on 09.07.2020. IMMO Infotech is leading company in business

analytics and the MoU covers placement, student internships, exchange of knowledge, etc. In addition to this, the college signed another MoU with **IQVIA, an American Multinational Company** for five years. IQVIA has agreed to give a 100 hour short term course in data science to the students. After the completion of course, students will be placed as Data Scientists in IQVIA. The college also renewed its agreement with **Data Camp, USA**. All these MoUs have been initiated by the department of statistics.

9. Academic and Administrative Auditing

The external Academic and Administrative Audit for the academic year 2020-21 was carried out by a team consisting of **Prof. (Dr) Gabriel Simon Thattil, Director of IQAC, University of Kerala, Dr. Sunny Kuriakose, Dean, Student Affairs and Dr. T M Joseph, Principal, Mount Carmel College, Karukadom** on 8th -9th February 2021. The internal audit was done by a team consisting of Manager, Higher Education Secretary, Principal and IQAC Coordinator on 17-18 September 2020.

10. Faculty Development Programmes

- a. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell and Postgraduate and Research Department of Commerce organized a national level faculty development programme on **'Publishing in Scopus Indexed and UGC CARE List Journals'** on 30.05.2020. **Prof. R K Singh, Head and Dean, Delhi School of Economics, University of Delhi** was the main resource person.
- b. The IQAC and financial literacy cell of the college jointly organized a webinar for teaching and non-teaching staff on **'Covid 19 & Personal Financial Planning'** on 08.05.2020. **Sri. V K Adarsh, Senior Technical Manager, Union Bank of India** was the resource person.
- c. The IQAC of the college organized a one day FDP on **'Good Documentation Practices'** on 28.08. 2020. **Sri. N K Nikhil, Assistant Professor, Rajagiri College of Social Sciences** was the resource person.

11. Google Cloud Career Readiness Programme

The college got selected for the prestigious **'Google Cloud Readiness Programme'** of Google Academics and 28 students got selected to the programme. Dr.

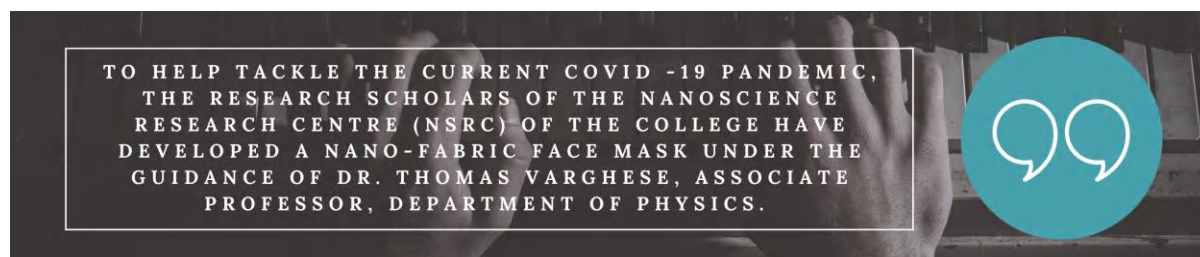
T M Jacob was the coordinator of the programme and he has successfully completed the course 'Architecting with Google Complete Engine'.

13. New Nano-fabric Face Mask – Dr. Thomas Varghese

To help tackle the current Covid -19 pandemic, the research scholars of the Nanoscience Research Centre (NSRC) of the college have developed a **nano-fabric face mask under the guidance of Dr. Thomas Varghese**, Associate Professor, Department of Physics. The patenting process is ongoing.

The college added more modules in its android mobile application ‘CamPulse’ such as **Student Grievance Redressal and Work Diary for teachers, Blood Bank, etc.** Now the students can submit their grievances related to academic, library, office, ragging, exams, and hostel, etc., through CamPulse.

17. Ms. Jwala Treasa Jaison in UNESCO Committee

Ms. Jwala Treasa Jaison, BA Communicative English student got selection to the **UNESCO Committee in the International Model UN 24th Online Conference** held on 26.09.2020. She spoke on ‘**Propagating the Fundamental Rights to Information during Pandemic**’.



18. National Level Quiz Competitions

- a. As part of celebrating **140th birth anniversary of Premchand**, Postgraduate and Research Department of Hindi organized a national level quiz competition on 31.07.2020.
- b. The IQAC and Quiz Club of the college has conducted a national quiz on the theme ‘**ICT Tools in Learning**’ on 26.01.2021.

- c. Postgraduate and Research Department of Commerce and **Ernakulam Branch of SIRC of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India** organized a **National Level Accounting Quiz** as part of the **International Accounting Day Celebrations** on 10.11.2020.

19. Infrastructural Augmentation

Nine new classrooms were added in addition to **two smart classrooms with 4K Interactive Board**. The college also constructed new **car parking facility (30 vehicles)** for teachers. The construction of new academic block under RUSA project is in Work-in-Progress stage.

20. Nirmala Hastham – New Study Centre at Kuttampuzha Panchayat

The college has come up with a study centre for around 50 students from tribal settlement in Kuttampuzha Panchayat in July 2020. This initiative really helped the students in that area to sustain their academic interest.

21. Financial Literacy Enhancement Initiatives

- b. The financial literacy cell of the college in association with IQAC organized a workshop on **‘How to Create a Financial Plan’** for UG and PG students on 09.10.2020. UGC has sanctioned seven **B.Voc Programmes** and one **Certificate Course** under the National Skills Qualifications Framework (NSQF). Since the programmes

have been sanctioned after the closure of the admission process of the university, the college did not offer these programmes for the academic year 2020-21.

III. STUDENT ENROLMENT

B. Career Guidance & Placements

7. Training program on “Upgrade Yourself” Session Two

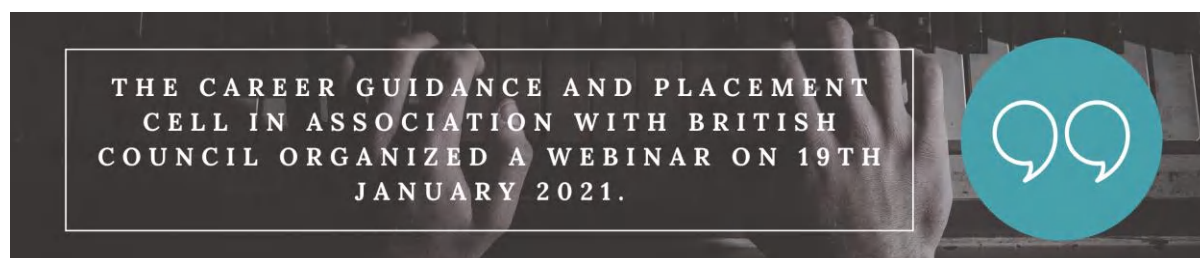

X. INFRASTRUCTURE AND LEARNING RESOURCES

1. NLIST -INFLIBNET registration: The central library started registration of NLIST-INFLIBNET from April 2020 onwards for students, research scholars and faculties as part of increasing the use of E-Resources during challenging time of COVID-19 pandemic. The authorized users can access e-resources and download articles required by them directly from various publishers. These resources include 6,150 e-journals and 31,64,309 e-books.

2. Digitization Project: The central library has initiated digitization of college magazines from June 2020 onwards. All resource materials that can be digitised are

being converted from their hard copies to electronic copies to enhance access and improve preservation of library materials. Pdfs of all magazines from 1956 onwards were digitised and made available to members. Their copies were uploaded in the library blog also.

3. DELNET Webinar: The library has held a webinar for students and faculty on October 24, 2020 in association with DELNET (Developing Library Services), JNU Campus, New Delhi and the IQAC of the college. *Topic: DELNET Networked Resources & Services: Discovery Portal & Knowledge Gainer Portal.* Its aim was to enlighten the members of college community on resource sharing among the libraries through the development of a network of libraries by DELNET and their services to users. The webinar hosted by Dr. Sangeeta Kaul, Director, DELNET became a very informative experience for the community.

4. Library Orientation: The central libraryorganised library Orientation Classes via Google Meet and Youtube in October 2020 and December 2020 for UG and PG Students. The discourse was led by Mr. Jomy Jose, Librarian, and aimed to orient library users on how to locate the information they needed quickly and effectively. The class also covered library books classification, available library resources, timings, library rules, e-resources etc.

5. Separate Room for differently abled users: The central libraryset up a separate room for differently abled users near the library circulation counter, close to the entrance of the library. It has been equipped with adjustable tables and drinking water facilities, Kibo XS scanning & reading device,CDs/DVDs. KIBO XS a device for the visually challenged was purchased from Trestle Labs. Kibo XS can connect with any computer or any Android smartphone to read any printed or handwritten document in audio across 11 Indian- (English, Hindi, Marathi, Gujarati, Bengali, Punjabi, Tamil, Telugu, Kannada, Malayalam, Sanskrit) and multiple overseas languages. Visually-impaired individuals pursuing higher-education get real-time access to any kind of content- printed (text/reference books) or handwritten (class notes of friends).

6. Braille magazines: The library subscribed for Braille magazine -White Print, India's First English Lifestyle in Braille.

7. Gandhi Dharshanik Sthal and display of Gandhian Literature: In connection with Gandhi Awareness among students a total of 380 books covered 100 volumes of works on Mahatma Gandhi, on his life and his principles, the freedom struggle under his leadership, Grama Swaraj, Women empowerment etc. added to library stock. The Dharshanik Sthal in front of the Central library also displays portraits and photos from the life of Mahatma Gandhi in light of his 150th birth anniversary.

8. Library blog: The library blog was revamped for giving updated information to its users using The Blogger. (<https://nirmalacollegelibrary.blogspot.com>)

9. Rare books Collection: The Nirmala College library launched a rare books Collection project called "Apoorva" to collect rare books, magazines, 'thaaliyola' manuscripts etc. This is part of the library's drive to collect and preserve knowledge with the help of the public and the alumni. More than 200 books were added to Rare books collection.

10. Training for library science graduates: Library provided training for two library science graduates in 2020-21 period which covered library classification, circulation, data entry, book processing, shelf rectification, stock verification etc. .

11. Prasirini : Disseminating knowledge to public users-the college central library was opened to the public by Shri.P P Eldhose,Municipal Chairman (Muvattupuzha Municipality) as an extension service on 06-02-2021.

12. The college has constructed two smart classrooms.

13. The college purchased 58 new computers in this academic year.

14. 4K Interactive Boards were purchased and made available for use.

15. 2 LCD projectors are added to the ICT facilities.

14. Sonic Firewall is established for digital protection.

14. Zoology Museum renovated during this academic year.

XIII. FUTURE PLANS

1. **Autonomy Status**

The college seeks autonomous status to become a pursuit of knowledge which leads to the holistic development of its neighbouring community and the country. In this direction, a master plan for the future development of Nirmala Campus will be prepared.

2. **New Examination Building**

New examination building will be constructed for the smooth functioning of examination and allied sections.

3. **Creation of Digital Knowledge**

Technological advancement and innovations in educational transactions have to be undertaken by all HEIs, to make a visible impact on academic development as well as administration. At a time when our educational institutions are expected to perform as good as their global partners, significant technological innovations have to be adopted. To keep pace with the developments, HEIs have to enrich the learning experiences of their students by providing them with state-of-the-art educational technologies. The campus community must be adequately prepared to make use of Information and Communication Technology (ICT) optimally.

- a) WI-FI facility for students in Library, Main Block, PG Block and Diamond Jubilee Block
- b) Up gradation of all existing class rooms to digital class rooms
- c) Installation of Video Conferencing facilities
- d) Media Lab (Teaches in College need to produce video lessons to post it in the College Website, Moodle and Google class rooms)
- e) Construction of Smart class rooms in Each block with state-of-the-art educational technologies
- f) More Computers for labs.
- g) Up gradation of Language Lab

4. **Roofing of Main Block and PG Block**

The roofing of main block and PG Block are expected to be completed in the next year.

5. **Software for Data Base Management**

The college is planning to purchase a software for data base management which will help in various accreditation processes.

6. Annex to the Main Academic Block

It is proposed to have an annex to the main Academic block. The proposed block will address the problem of inadequacies in the scientific laboratories housed in the main block. The new block will connect the main block with the Silver Jubilee Block (PG Block). The estimated cost for the construction is Rs.1,00,00,000/- which is expected to be covered under RUSA.

7. Tiling the Verandahs of the Main Block.

The verandhas and corridors of the main block are old fashioned. It needs to be modernized. Therefore, we propose to tile the verandhas and corridors of the main block. The expenditure is to be met from the RUSA grant sanctioned.

8. Conversion of the terrace of administrative block into an auditorium

The terrace of the newly constructed administrative block is now in the process of roofing. It is proposed to convert the area into an auditorium with a tiled floor. The expenditure is expected to be met from the RUSA grant sanctioned.

9. Connecting bridge between the main block and the administrative block on the first floor.

Though the main block, auditorium block, administrative block and the Library block are now connected, that is only at the ground floor level of the main block. We propose to erect a connecting bridge between the main block and the auditorium block at the first floor level of the main block, which would provide easy access to the students and teachers in the main block to the proposed auditorium (above administrative block) and the Library building. The cost is expected to be met by the RUSA grant sanctioned.

10. Promotion of Research Facilities

The promotion of research is a significant responsibility of the HEIs particularly for colleges without which a 'research culture' on campus cannot be realised. Since we have seven research departments the following are necessary

- a. More research journals in addition to Science & Society
- b. Up gradation of Publication Wing

11. Green Initiatives will Continue

NAAC examines whether an institution displays sensitivity to issues like climate change and environmental issues and adopts environment friendly practices. Since the college is going for reassessment and wants to highlight the green initiatives as one of the best practices, the following actions are necessary:

- a. Waste Water Treatment Plant
- b. Chemical Waste Treatment Plant
- c. Up gradation of Rain water Harvesting System
- d. Up gradation of Solar System
- e. Separate financial audit for Green practices
- f. Species of various plants and trees
