ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Nirmala College, Muvattupuzha was founded in 1953 and it has now become one of the premier educational institutions in India with more than 3000 students and 136 faculty members. POSTGRADUATE AND RESEARCH DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE

It was affiliated to the University of Kerala when the first batch of B.Com. course was started in July 1955 with 22 students and two teachers. The department became a centre of postgraduate studies in commerce in 1965. It was approved as a research centre in Commerce by the Mahatma Gandhi University in July 2000. In 2004 - 2005, the department celebrated its Golden Jubilee. The Department is an approved satellite centre of CMA. It is the biggest department in the college with more than 700 students and 25 teachers. Presently the Dept. has 29 Ph.Ds to its credit.
