

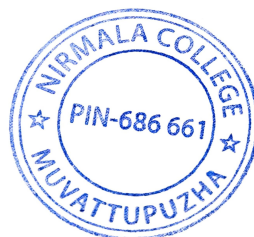
IQAC CURRICULUM FEEDBACK STAKEHOLDER ANALYSIS REPORT 2020-21



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FEEDBACK 2020-2021

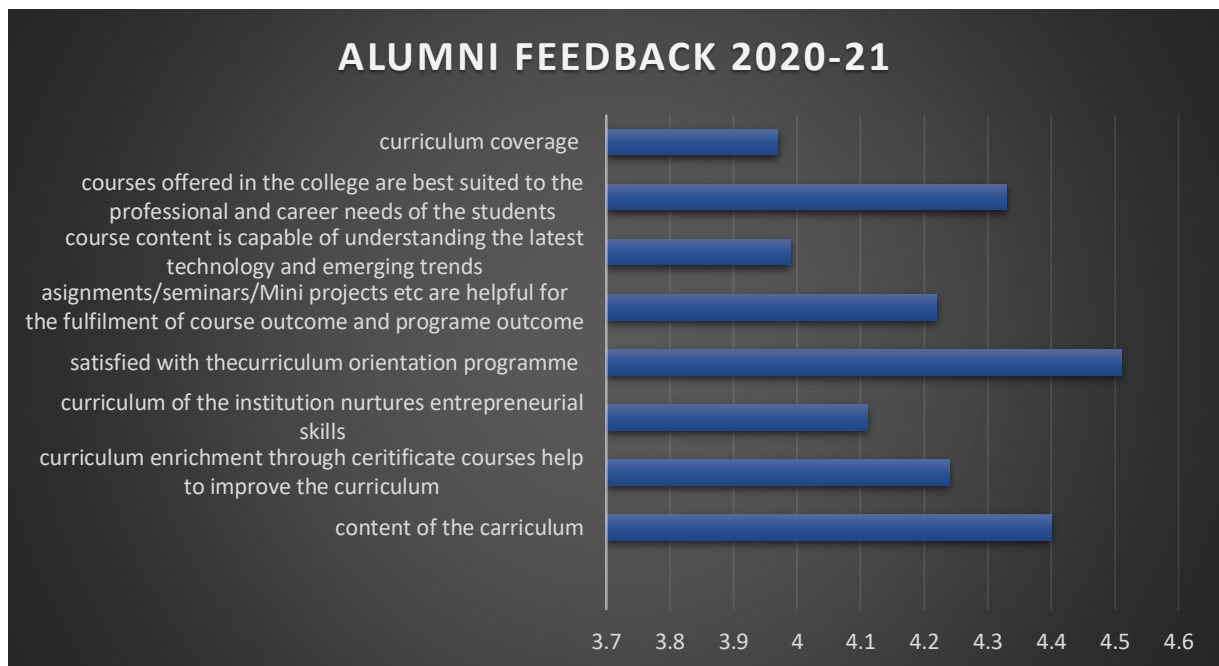
In the academic year 2020-21 also, the IQAC of Nirmala College has collected response from all the benefactors of the institution. A five point rating scale was used to analyse the responses. The maximum score assigned is 5 and the minimum score is one. A rate of 5 indicates that they are highly satisfied, 4 indicates satisfied, 3 indicates neutral, 2 indicates dissatisfied and 1 indicates highly dissatisfied. The result obtained are summarised below.

Alumni feedback 2020-21

Analysis of Alumni feedback revealed the following information:

- Most of the alumni are highly satisfied with the content of the curriculum. The rate given is 4.40/5
- Majority of the respondents admits that the curriculum enrichment through certificate courses help to improve the curriculum especially by inculcating entrepreneurial skills(4.24/5)
- It is also noted that the curriculum of the institution nurtures entrepreneurial skills(4.11/5)
- Alumni are also contented with the curriculum orientation programme organised by the departments(4.51/5)
- Ex-students have the opinion that assignments/seminars/Mini projects etc are helpful for the fulfilment of course outcome and programme outcome(4.22/5)
- Majority have the opinion course content is capable of understanding the latest technology and emerging trends(3.99/5).
- Besides, alumni also believe that the courses offered in the college are best suited to the professional and career needs of the students.(4.33/5)
- The curriculum coverage is adequate enough to meet the professional and job needs of the students. It is revealed through a score of 3.97.

The alumni had also given some important suggestions that will help to modify the curriculum delivery further. Some of the suggestions are introduction of more job oriented courses, discussions, interuniversity and interdepartmental competitions etc that will be beneficial to the student community.



EMPLOYER FEEDBACK 2020-21

Analysis of the feedback given by the employers revealed the following vital information about the curriculum

- Employers have the opinion that the curriculum offered by the institution had the proclivity to implement new methods and technology (4.46/5)
- Employers acknowledge the capacity of the program in producing problem cracking temperament and the ability to innovate in their teams. It is revealed through a score of 4.6/5.
- Moreover, employers also admit that the program offered in the institution fosters team spirit among the students (4.29/5).
- Employers are also comfortable with the soft-skills given by the curriculum and institution (4.53/5).
- On interpreting the response of the proprietors, it is noted that most of them are satisfied with the space given by the curriculum for inculcating professional conscience and positive thinking among the students (4.17/5).
- Moreover, it is recognized that the programmes offered in the college had the capacity to convey leadership potentials among the students (4.56/5).

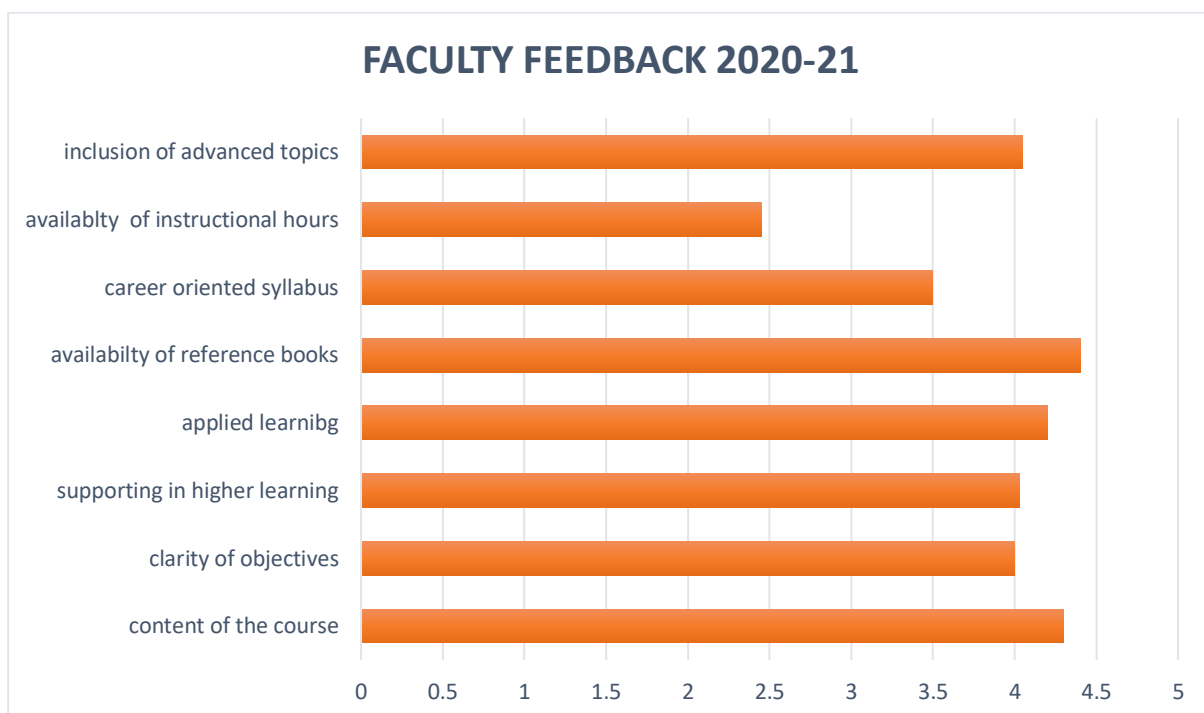


FACULTY FEEDBACK 2020-21

The ensuing facts were noted while analysing the faculty response for the year 2020-21

- Most of the faculty are contented with the content of the course (4.30/5).
- It is also noted that there is clarity in course objectives which can be identified from the score of 4/5.
- Faculty also pointed out that the present curriculum is capable of supporting the students in their higher learning 4.03/4.
- Faculty have the opinion that the courses offered are good in providing applied learning to the scholars (4.2/5).
- They are also satisfied with the number of reference books and also with the accessibility of instructional materials (4.4/5).
- Faculty also revealed that the current syllabus offered is career-oriented (3.50/5)
- A score of 2.45/5 for instructional hours indicates that most of them are dissatisfied with the instructional hours available to complete the syllabus.
- Moreover it is also noted that the syllabus is well enriched with the inclusion of advanced topics (4.05/5).

The faculty of the college had concrete perceptions for the enhancement of curriculum delivery process. Introduction of more carrier-oriented certificate courses, placement drives, more skill development programmes and more extracurricular activities will be beneficial to the entire students of the college.



STUDENT FEEDBACK

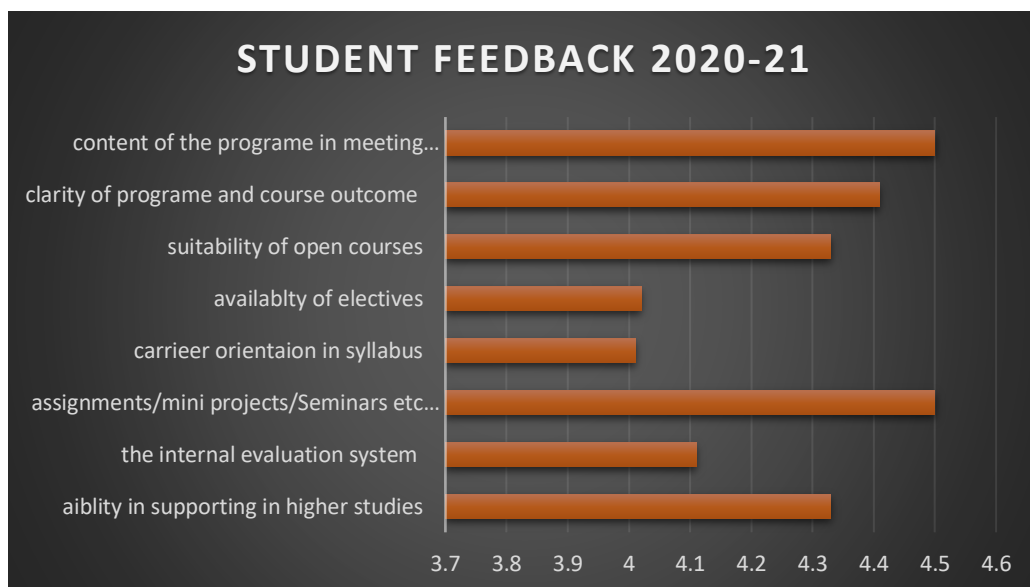
The student feedback on curricular aspects opened up the following:

- Students are contented with the capacity of the curriculum in supporting in their higher studies(4.33/5)
- They are also satisfied with the internal evaluation system followed in the college and curriculum.(4.11/5)
- Furthermore,they also have the view that the assignments/miniprojects/Seminars etc proposed in the program are supportive to accomplish the course and programme outcome(4/5).
- To most of the students the present syllabus is career-oriented (4.01)

- Feedback also revealed that the students are satisfied with the availability of elective(4.02/5) and open courses in the curriculum(4.33/5)
- The current curriculum is well appreciated both in terms of program and course outcome (4.41/5)
- Students have the opinion that the content of the program is good enough to meet their professional and job needs(4.50/5).

Some of the important recommendations given by the students are as follows

- Introduce more extra-curricular activities.
- Stick on with the practice of peer teaching.
- Facility for more recruitment
