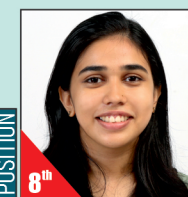

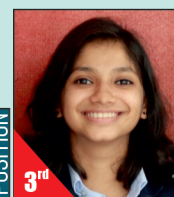

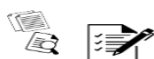

5. Chief Minister's Prathibha Award

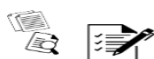
During this academic year, 11 students of the college have received Chief Minister's Prathibha Award of Rs. 1,00,000 each.

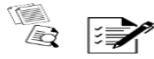

h. Hello Monday

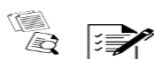

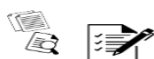
under the head 'Fluent Friday', to diffuse the content to the various stake holders of the college.

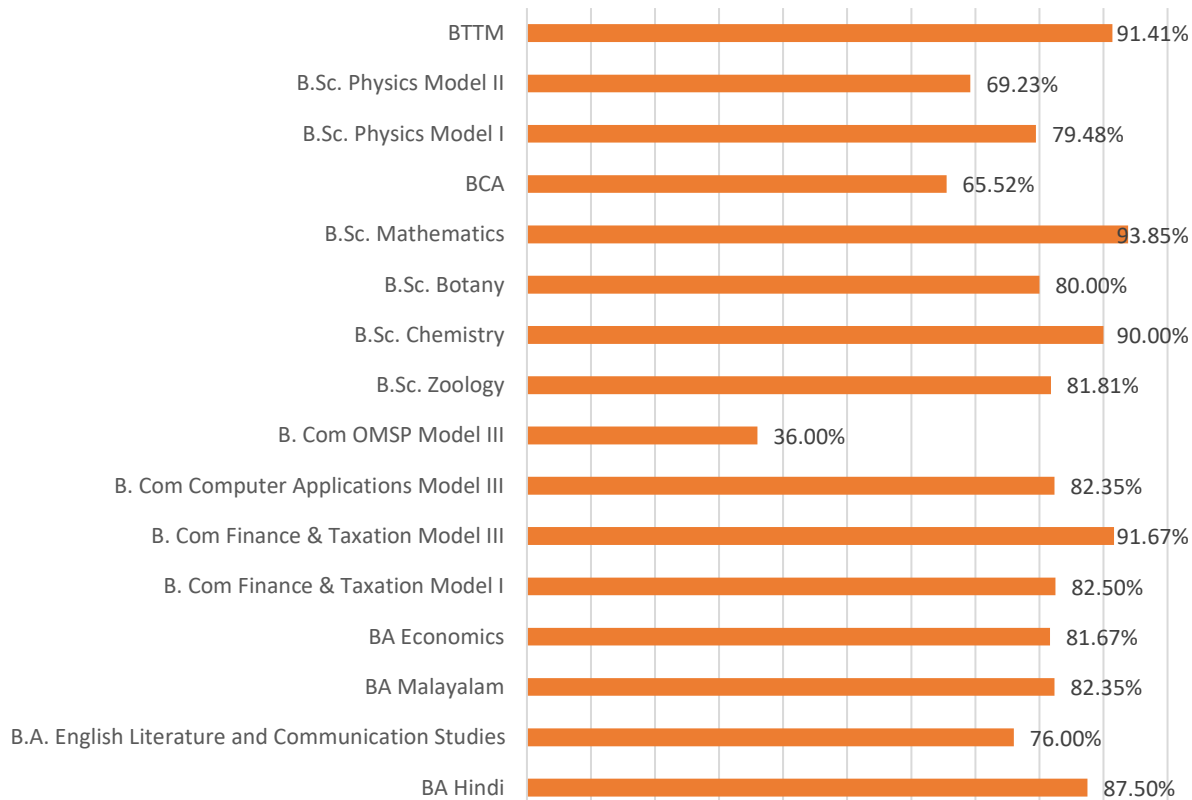

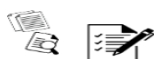
VI. FACULTY ACHIEVEMENTS

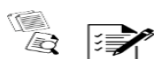


C. Professional Development of Faculty Members

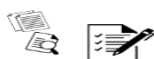

X. LIBRARY

- a. **NLIST -INFLIBNET Registration:** Registration of students, research scholars and faculties for NLIST-INFLIBNET beginning from April 2021. Emphasis is being laid more on E-resources by the Central Library due to the pandemic. Authorized users access e-resources from a collection of 6,150 e-journals and 31,64,309 e-books under NLIST program. Users can also download articles directly from the publisher's website.



- b. **Digitization Project:** After successful digitisation of all college magazines from 1956 onwards its pdfs are now available to library members. Their copies can be accessed on the library blog as well.
- c. **Library Orientation:** The central library Orientation Classes are organised via Google Meet and Youtube for UG and PG Students by Mr. Jomy Jose, Librarian. This class provides information on library book classification, available library resources, timings, library rules, e-resources etc and trains users to locate required information effectively and quickly.
- d. **DELNET:** Central Library has a yearly membership of DELNET (Developing Library Network, J.N.U Campus) This enables it to borrow books from various libraries, get photocopies of select articles for research and reference through their online catalogue and database. Institutional members of DELNET can share their e-resources as well. DELNET provides delivery of individual books and photocopies of local and international articles as and when required by member libraries through the Inter Library Loan/Document Delivery Services.
- e. **Gandhian Literature:** Central library houses 380 books and over 100 volumes related to Gandhian Studies; accessible to all members.
- f. **Library Blog:** The new library blog (<https://nirmalacollegelibrary.blogspot.com>) gives timely updates on the college library activities and services.
- g. **Training for Library Science Graduates:** The Library provided training for two library science graduates between 2021-22. It covered library classification, circulation, data entry, book processing, shelf rectification, stock verification etc.
- h. **Prasirini :** Disseminating knowledge to public users-the college central library is opened to the public from time to time (based on Covid mandates in place) as an extension service.



- i. **Library Binding:** Books and journals binding is a preservation technique and a necessary ritual for library print resources. The library ensures binding and preservation of damaged resources regularly.
- j. **Preservation of back volumes of Journals:** previous volumes of important journal issues are bound and archived regularly.
- k. **Rare Books Preservation:** The Nirmala Central Library preserves around 201 rare books in foreign languages and 11 Braille books.
- l. **Question Paper Archives:** Previous years' question papers are digitised and archived with the library stock reference section.
- m. **Publications by Staff.**

1. Autonomy Status

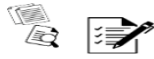
