Scope of Problem Statement

The Ideation Hackathon seeks innovative solutions to maximize environmental and economic benefits from waste streams, emphasizing plastic and electronic waste. It encourages original ideas for waste-to-wealth conversion, focusing on reuse, reduction, recycling, refurbishing, and repurposing, while excluding existing waste regulations to foster creativity and novelty.



Purpose of this Hackathon

The purpose of this ideation hackathon is to encourage the best young brains in the country to

- 1. Present novel concepts for waste utilization, process enhancements, engineering solutions, and technical advancements to facilitate waste-to-wealth transformation.
- 2. Recognize valuable resources and products within waste streams, and propose specialized, innovative, and multidimensional solutions for their use. Aim to add value to supply chains and explore or develop new market opportunities.

This Hackathon aims to encourage young innovators to leverage their analytical and problem-solving skills, combined with technical expertise, to address real-world waste challenges at the grassroots level. It will enhance their understanding of waste management, foster clearer thinking, and generate innovative solutions for converting waste into wealth.

Eligibility Criteria

All undergraduates, postgraduates, students of professional courses (arts/science/management stream), research scholars and students from technology & engineering fields or startups associated with incubation centres of any institution are eligible to participate in this contest.

- Students are allowed to participate as individuals or teams of up to five members.
- Eligible participants are required to complete the registration process by 10th September 2024.

By participating in the Waste Management Hackathon, you will contribute to developing sustainable solutions that can address the waste management crisis and pave the way for a healthier, cleaner planet.



Hackathon Process

- The hackathon comprises of two phases idea phase and demonstration phase. Idea phase will be in online mode and demonstration phase will be in offline mode (Applicable only for finalists)
- The interested applicants are required to register for the hackathon by September 10, 2024, on https://forms.gle/ZfdSpnW5sZ2gEA1S9.
- One problem statement either of the two or both waste categories (i) Plastic waste and (iii) Electronic waste are considered
- The registered candidates shall be required to submit their ideas/solutions
- No entries will be accepted after the deadline.
- No changes will be accepted once the proposal is submitted.
- The shortlisted ideas/solutions (3 each in both categories) shall be intimated through email to candidates by September 25, 2024
- The shortlisted ideators shall be invited to make a presentation in college before the Evaluation Committee which will be on second week of October 2024. The results (2 each in both categories) will be declared on that day followed by award ceremony


Evaluation Parameters

- Degree of innovation.
- Waste to Wealth ratio.
- Simplicity & uniqueness of the proposed solution.
- Practicability & Sustainability of the solution
- Scale of impact on the society
- Robustness and replicability.
- Potential for future application.
- Operational feasibility.
- Adherence to at least one of the SDGs
