The college student union took up a major extension activity in the form of mobilizing Rs.2,50,000 for constructing a house for a widow at Mudavur, Smt. Sheela Madhu, whose husband was killed in a motor accident. The contribution was of great help to the family as they did not have any means to overcome the crisis. The teachers, non-teaching staff and students generously contributed to the fund.

WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY CELEBRATION

The World Environment Day Lecture was delivered by Dr. V.S. Vijayan, the famous environmental activist and former Chairman, Kerala Bio-diversity Board on 12 June 2017. The lecture was held under the auspices of Zoology and Botany Departments with college union and sponsored by Kerala State Council for Science Technology and Environment. The lecture was co-ordinated by Dr. Gigi K. Joseph and Ms. Jaiby Cyriac. The World Environmental Day was celebrated on 12 June 2017, with the financial support of KSCSTE. Dr. V.S.
