Pulwama Attack

01 March 2019

NCC cadets of Nirmala college had conducted a program in remembrance of Pulwama attack and the air strike to avenge Pulwama. The program started at about 4:15 pm on 01/03/2019. The class was held by our Care taker Professor Abin Wilson. Our Senior Under Officer Anto Mathew and the other cadets, also supervised the class. Our NCC cadets also joined the sorrowful situation, of the families of the passed away soldiers of CRPF. Professor Abin Wilson also added about the issues at the India Pak border. He had also explained about the Geneva Convention, in detail.

At least 40 central reserve police force paramilitary troopers were killed in the deadliest terror attack witnessed in three decades of Kashmir's insurgency. The Pulwama attack occurred on Februray 14, 2019 when a 78-vehicle convoy was escorting over 2,500 CRPF jawans from Jammu to Srinagar. The responsibility for the attack was claimed by the Pakistan based Islamist militant group Jaish-e-Mohammed. But Pakistan condemned the attack and denied any connection to it.

In response the Indian air force conducted airstrikes on 26th February 2019, over the line of control in Kashmir. On 26th and 27th February, India and Pakistan exchanged fire across the LOC. Pakistan claimed that two jets were shot down over Pakistani airspace and one pilot captured. India demanded the release of the pilot, and Pakistan announced to release him on 1st March 2019 via wagha border as a peace gesture. Prime Minister Narendhra Modhi welcomed Abhinandhan on 1st march 2019, at a political rally.Indian media criticized the Pakistani government for not adhering the protocols of Geneva conventions, since they publicly released the photographs and interrogation videos.After the class lead by Care taker professor Abin Wilson, the class dispersed by 5 pm. All of us prayed for the safe release of the great IAF wing

commander Abhinanadan Varthaman.

08 March 2019




MAVALANGAR DEMO CLASS


LIVER DAY


NO TOBACCO CAMPAIGN




AVEGA-2K19

20th March 2020








ONAM KIT PACKING

It is our duty to protect our nature. This should not be finished in a particular day, we should think every day about the need of protecting environment not only for our sake but also for the future.




YOGA DAY CELEBRATION

YOGA DAY QUIZ




21st June 2020


BLOOD DONATION







WORLDMENTAL HEALTH DAY




REPUBLIC DAY PARADE -2020-21
