ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Nirmala College, Muvattupuzha was founded in 1953 and it has now become a premier educational institution in India with over 3000 students and 136 faculty members. The college offers 17 undergraduate programmes, 14 postgraduate programmes, one integrated PG programme and 7 research programmes. The Campus is located in the naturally blessed Nirmala hills which is spread over nearly 53 acres of land on the way side of Muvattupuzha –Thodupuzha Highway. In 2017, the Ministry of MHRD, Government of India, ranked Nirmala College on the 91st position among all colleges in India under the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF). ADMISSION NORMS

- ▶ All candidates need to register online on the MG university CAP admission portal (www.cap.mgu.ac.in)
- ▶ Application for consideration under community merit, Management quota need to apply in the college also.
- ▶ Application forms neatly and correctly filled up may be sent to the Principal with self-attested copy of marklists. Incomplete applications will be summarily rejected.
- ▶ Selection of candidates will be made on the basis of merit, conduct and character and personal interview.
- ▶ Applicants who are being favourably considered, will be called for an interview. The applicant, accompanied by his/her parent/guardian, is to appear before the Principal for interview and produce the records called for.
- ▶ NCC/NSS students at the level of course immediately preceding the programme for which admission is sought will get bonus marks of 15 for admission to the U.G. programmes and 5 for PG programmes. Holders of B & C certificates of NCC at the level of course immediately preceding the programme for which admission is sought are entitled to an additional bonus of 5 marks. Children of Ex-Service men are entitled to 15 bonus marks for admission to UG/PG Programmes.
- ▶ A penalty of 5 marks will be imposed for every successive attempt after the first attempt to pass the qualifying examination.
- ▶ Admission process will be complete on payment of the first instalment of fees and submission of the necessary documents.



NOTES

- ▶ Every applicant is required to be aware the rules and regulations of the campus and any atrocities against other students like ragging, manhandling etc. are banned in the college campus and hence the violation of rules are punishable.
- ▶ Fee concession will be available as per the Govt. norms
- ▶ Note down your APPLICATION NUMBER for easy reference.
- ▶ Original Certificates once deposited, will not be returned before the completion of the Programme.
- ▶ Parents and guardians shall accept all the regulations prevailing in the college. They are recommended to visit the college at least once in a semester to ascertain the progress of the student in the college.
