PROFILE OF THE COLLEGE

Nirmala College, Muvattupuzha was founded in 1953 and it has now become one of the premier educational institutions in India with more than 3000 students and 136 faculty members. It is a Minority Christian institution governed and managed by the Corporate Educational Agency, Syrian Catholic Diocese of Kothamangalam, Kerala. The college is known for its high academic standards, and the students bag university ranks on a continuous basis. The college is reaccredited by NAAC with A++ grade (CGPA 3.73) in the fourth cycle of accreditation in 2021. The college was ranked on the 91st position in the NIRF rankings 2017 by the Ministry of Education, Government of India and is also bestowed with the prestigious 'Star College' status by the DBT, Government of India. All Science departments of the college are supported by the DST FIST scheme.

The college offers 17 Undergraduate programmes, 13 Postgraduate programmes and One Integrated Postgraduate programme. In addition to this, the college also offers Ph.D. programmes in Seven disciplines.



BACKGROUND OF THE CONFERENCE

One of the thrust areas of National Education Policy 2020 (NEP 2020) is the adoption of flexible structures in the undergraduate curriculum to introduce holistic and multidisciplinary education that would help to develop various competencies of learners. NEP 2020 envisages competency development as the integration of intellectual, aesthetic, social, physical, emotional and ethical capacities. NEP 2020 and UGC specify that capacity development may not be possible through the existing three year UG curriculum framework where the opportunity for teachers and learners to innovate is minimum. The new Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) curriculum framework is expected to achieve the broader objectives of NEP with respect to higher education.

OBJECTIVES OF THE CONFERENCE

The objective of the conference is to spread awareness and impart knowledge on the proposed curriculum framework of FYUGP. It also intends to familiarise the inter-connectedness between National Education Policy (NEP 2020) and the curriculum framework. This conference is expected to deliberate on the pros and cons of the new curriculum framework and to evolve ways to implement it in the best interest of the society. The conference also provides hands on sessions on outcome based education (OBE) to the participants.
